Common Definitional Features

- An interactive computer-based and internet-connected learning environment;
- Students are separated from their teachers by time or location, or both;
- Certified teachers required; and
- Distinguishes between schools and courses, and full and part time options

- Online experience as high school graduation requirement
- Determining appropriateness of online learning instruction for SWDs
- Provision of special education and related services in online learning
- Reporting requirements



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

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
